2. Committee member Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jeff Naquin, "THAT, the committee approve payment of the bills submitted through July 22, 2022." The motion was unanimously adopted.
3. Chairman Patrick Johnson recognized the Secretary-Treasurer, who stated that the Budget Comparison Statements are included for review. She stated that there are no items that require special plans and recommends approval.
4. Committee member Jeff Naquin offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the committee approve and accept the Budget Comparison Statements for June 2022." The motion was unanimously adopted.
5. Committee member Chris Carter offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Ron Alcorn, "THAT, the committee approve the purchase of 2 lawn mowers off State Bid contract in the amount of \$23,019." The motion was unanimously adopted.
6. Chairman Patrick Johnson recognized the Assistant Parish Manager, who stated that he received quotes to purchase 2 maintenance vehicles and 1 for Road & Bridge in the amount of \$150,000. Following a brief discussion, the committee agreed that this purchase must be bid out since there are no vehicles available on state contract.

8. The Assistant Parish Manager stated that he received a quote of \$150,000 to purchase a flat bed truck and a trailer. He briefly explained the need for both pieces of equipment.

2. Chairman Irving Comeaux recognized the Parish Engineer, who stated that the Napoleonville Multi-Trail Connection Project is over budget and will provide more information at an upcoming meeting.
3. Committee member Jeff Naquin offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jamie Ponville, "THAT, the committee approve to start the procurement process for the upgrade of the Parish Sewer Systems to be funded through the American Recovery Act." The motion was unanimously adopted.
4. Chairman Irving Comeaux recognized the Grants Coordinator, who requested a list of projects to submit for the CDBG funding as well as Capital Outlay. He stated that CDBG projects can consist of streets and sewer projects and low to moderate areas have better opportunity. Police Juror Chris Carter suggested Ewell and Virginia Streets Sewer Projects. In response, the Grants Coordinator stated that the Parish can apply for up to \$800,000 and informed them that the deadline for submittal is November 21, 2022. The committee agreed to review and submit prior projects for the Capital Outlay funding. The also agreed that this will be further discussed at the meeting of August 24, 2022. In response, the Grants Coordinator stated that the deadline date for this application is November 1, 2022. The committee also discussed the Water Sector Grant. The Grants Coordinator informed the committee that the deadline date is August 31, 2022.

2. Police Jurors recorded as present were: Mr. Ron Alcorn, Ward 1; Mr. Jeff Naquin, Ward 2; Mr. Irving Comeaux, Ward 3; Mr. Patrick Johnson, Ward 4; Mr. Michael Dias, Ward 5; Mr. Chris Carter, Ward 6; Mr. Leroy Blanchard, Ward 7; Mr. Jamie Ponville, Ward 8; Police Juror recorded as absent was: Mr. Myron Matherne, Ward 9.
3. President Patrick Johnson led the Prayer and Police Juror Chris Carter led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
4. Police Juror Michael Dias offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Chris Carter, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the minutes of July 13, 2022." The motion was unanimously adopted.
5. President Patrick Johnson opened the meeting to the public for any public comments, questions or concerns regarding the items listed on the agenda. Following three (3) calls, there were no comments received.
6. President Patrick Johnson recognized Drainage Committee Chairman Jamie Ponville, who stated that the committee met and recommended the following matters; drainage project overruns, \$933.48 for culvert replacement at 405 Maple St.- #92986, \$613.70 for culvert replacement on Pond Dr.- #92908, \$29.93 for culvert replacement at 4038 Hwy 1- #93003 and \$447.11 for culvert replacement at 198 Bayou Tranquille-#93007, to transfer \$1,500 from Ward 7 drainage allocation to Pierre Part Settlement Drainage District, payment of \$205 for Lower Texas Drainage District recording fees, table the replacement of Shaye Toups on the Bayou L'Ourse Drainage District until the next meeting, \$400 for Lucky Hit Outfall to Baker Canal Sweeping Project, \$2,020 for 220 Pecan St. Culvert Replacement Project, \$1,020 for 228 Pecan St. Culvert Replacement Project, \$1,550 for 2911 Highway 1 Culvert Replacement Project, \$1,570 for 2560 Highway 70 Culvert Replacement Project and \$300 from Ward 4 allocation for South Bay Rd. Outfall Sweeping Project.
7. Police Juror Jamie Ponville offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Leroy Blanchard, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the Drainage Committee report as presented." The motion was unanimously adopted.
8. President Patrick Johnson stated that the Finance Committee met and recommended the following matters; payment of the bills submitted through July 22, 2022, accept the Budget Comparison Statements for June 2022, the purchase of 2 lawn mowers off State Bid contract in the amount of \$23,019, bidding out the purchase of 2 maintenance vehicles and 1 for Road & Bridge, \$150,000 from the drainage fund to purchase a flatbed truck and a trailer, charging a \$25 NSF handling fee to residents, a change order for Carter Construction in the amount of \$2,973 due to unforeseen circumstances under the Housing Preservation Grant and authorized the Jurors to meet with the Congressional Delegation in Washington, DC on September 18-21, 2022 at a cost of \$1,500 per Juror.
9. Police Juror Jamie Ponville offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the Finance Committee report as presented." The motion was unanimously adopted
10. President Patrick Johnson recognized Personnel Committee Chairman Chris Carter, who stated that the committee met and recommended the following matters: the personnel manual amendments as previously presented and 12 weeks of FMLA leave for a maintenance employee.
11. Police Juror Chris Carter offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jeff Naquin, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the Personnel Committee report as presented." The motion was unanimously adopted. (resolutions attached)
12. President Patrick Johnson recognized Road & Bridge Committee Chairman Ron Alcorn, who stated that the committee met and recommended the speed bumps application for Albarado St. (W7).
13. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the Road & Bridge Committee report as presented." The motion was unanimously adopted. (resolution attached)
14. President Patrick Johnson recognized Engineering/Grants Committee Chairman Irving Comeaux, who stated that the committee met and recommended the following matters; to start the

procurement process for the upgrade of the Parish Sewer Systems to be funded through the American Recovery Act, selected Ewell and Virginia Streets Sewer Projects for the CDBG Grant and authorized the Grants Coordinator to submit the application, authorized adding Thomas Long and Kim M. Torres to the Signatory Authorities for the Office of Community Development Disaster Recovery Program due to John Boudreaux's retirement and authorized the Police Jury President to sign the Capital Outlay Data forms.

15. Police Juror Irving Comeaux offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jamie Ponville, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the Engineering/Grants committee report as presented." The motion was unanimously adopted. (resolutions attached)
16. President Patrick Johnson recognized Kayla Guerrero, Regional Administrator, who introduced Dr. Brooks, Region 3, Louisiana Department of Health, who briefly spoke on their focus of Mental Health and stated that it is essential to your overall health. He stated that mental health concern become a mental illness when ongoing signs and symptoms cause frequent stress and affect your ability to function. He also stated that this is why mental health awareness has become the primary need for the people. Dr. Brooks then gave a brief update on COVID and stated that it is spiking up again. He stated that most people are taking home test therefore, the numbers are not as accurate and the death rate is not as high. He also touched on Monkey Pox and briefly explained how It's begin transmitted. On behalf of the Jury, President Patrick Johnson thanked Dr. Brooks for the introduction and the update.
17. President Patrick Johnson recognized Paula Rome, Entergy Customer Service Representative, who briefly introduced herself and stated that Stacy Fontenot will still be assisting her in the Parish. She then stated that they will be available for anything that the Parish may need.
18. President Patrick Johnson recognized Cliff Crochet, who gave a brief presentation on the "Every Fish Matters" Campaign. He spoke about bass fishing and how it impacts people and stated it's potential for Lake Verret Basin. He mentioned the plan to re-stock Lake Verret with small bass. A brief discussion was held on what can Wildlife and Fisheries could do on a state level. Police Juror Leroy Blanchard stated that he would be interested in contributing \$1,000 from his recreation allocation to the cause. In response, Police Juror Irving Comeaux stated that this will open the door for other fisherman in the Parish to approach the Jury with a similar request and how will that be handled. Following a brief discussion, President Patrick Johnson suggested that Police Jurors Leroy Blanchard and Jamie Ponville lead the cause for further information and to meet with Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries. He also requested that they confer with the ADA to come up with legal ways that the Parish may render assistance.
19. President Patrick Johnson recognized Chelsie Rodrigue, Lower Texas Drainage District, who stated that their election cost is \$8,600 in accordance with the Secretary of State's Office. She stated that it would take the District about 3 years to cover the cost which isn't feasible. Therefore, she is requesting assistance from the Parish to cover the cost. President Patrick Johnson stated that he would request approval to allocate the funds needed for the election fees from the Ward 4 drainage allocation.
20. Police Juror Irving Comeaux offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jamie Ponville, "THAT, the Police Jury approve allocating \$8,600 through Ward 4 Drainage funds to the Lower Texas Drainage District to cover the election cost." The motion was unanimously adopted.
21. Police Juror Jamie Ponville offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Irving Comeaux, "THAT, the Police Jury approve an occupational license submitted by Sweet Pea & Pup LLC, Baby N Style, La Maison de Fleur, LLC and The Business Money Store, LLC." The motion was unanimously adopted.
22. **ORDINANCE NO. 22-08**

**An ordinance to amend Chapter 2, Sub-Chapter “B” of the Code of Ordinances, Sections 50, 51, and 53 to establish and define Wards and Precincts and Establishing Polling Places.**

WHEREAS, as specified in Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1411 the Assumption Parish Police Jury is required to examine and if necessary redraw the boundaries of the voting districts every ten (10) years in accordance with the decennial census; and,

WHEREAS, the Census was taken in 2020, and the population data was released by the Census Bureau in August of 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Assumption Parish Police Jury has examined, reviewed, and considered various alternative alignments based upon the findings of the United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census; and,

WHEREAS, the Assumption Parish Police Jury has selected the considered map alignment entitled **Alternative 3-A**; now,

**THEREFORE, THE ASSUMPTION PARISH POLICE JURY HEREBY ORDAINS** that in accordance with applicable law, that **Chapter 2, Sub-Chapter “B” of the Code of Ordinances, Sections 50, 51, and 53 defining Wards, Precincts, and Polling Places** are hereby amended and established as described as follows:
