

PUBLIC NOTICE for PUBLIC COMENTS

Assumption Parish, Louisiana

The Assumption Parish Police jury will be accepting public comments for 7 days from July 16th to July 22nd. The purpose of the comment period is to obtain views on the housing and community development needs of the Assumption Parish and to discuss the submission of an application for funding through the State of Louisiana *Community Development Block Grant* under the Resilient Communities Infrastructure Program (RCIP). The following items will be discussed at the hearing:

- A. The amount of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities;
- B. The range of activities available that may be undertaken, including the estimated amount of funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate incomes;
- C. The plans of the Assumption Parish for minimizing displaced persons as a result of activities assisted with such funds and the benefits to be provided by the Assumption Parish to persons actually displaced as a result of such activities; and,
- D. The Assumption Parish past performance on LCDBG projects funded by the State of Louisiana.

All residents, particularly those of low and moderate income and residents of slum and blighted areas of Assumption Parish are encouraged to submit comments.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities and/or limited English proficiency provided that three days' notice of received by the Assumption Parish.
